APPARATUS FOR TRANSPORTING STUDENTS

Page 1

This Administrative Regulation is written in accordance with the guiding principles of Policy No. BA-8.6, Transportation: Student Safety.

1. The Board offers transportation to students within the System, for a number of programs and using a variety of vehicles including
 - 1.1 full size school buses – e.g. sixty-six (66), seventy-two (72) passenger;
 - 1.2 smaller vehicles – twenty (20) passenger;
 - 1.3 wheelchair accessible vehicles;
 - 1.4 taxis, as required for special circumstances; and
 - 1.5 vehicles with adult bus monitors.
2. From time-to-time, vehicles must be adapted in order to provide the safest possible environment for the special high needs pupil, others riding the same vehicle, for the driver, and the general public.
3. Parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be advised that their son/daughter/foster child will be transported using a special apparatus (eg. four (4) point harness).
4. Parent(s)/guardian(s) shall acknowledge, in writing, that they understand and agree to the use of the special apparatus to ensure the safety of their child while being transported by the Board.
5. If this Acknowledgment is not received in writing, responsibility for transporting the student shall rest with the legal guardian.
6. Administrative Regulation BA-8.6.4A illustrates the standardized form to be completed by parent(s)/guardian(s).
